## b) Objections:

The subject matter claimed in claims 1-4 is not patentable u/s 3 (e) of Patents Act; since the formulation obtained by the mere admixutre of the components, resulting only in the aggregation of property, unless it is proved by the synergistic property between the components, and the same should be demonstrated.

Subject matter claimed in claim 2 is to definite for the scope of the claim, for which protection is desired as the claim 3 relates to the effect of the composition, which is achieved due to the composition of instant claims;

Subject matter claimed in 4 is not definite for the scope of the claim for which protection is desired as required by section 10 (4) (c) of Patents Act;

please note that a pre-grant opposition has been filed under section 25(1) of the Patents Act,(as amended) by Council of Scientifica & Industrial Reasearch Anusandhan Bhawan, New Delhi, the copy of the pre-grant representation is attached here with for your para wise comments, with respect to the cited docements clearly,
